The Board, with potentially three new Board Members and a new General Counsel onboard, will be adjudicating many important cases, and past decisions have addressed issues such as joint employer status, union representation in elections, employee handbooks, among others. Mr. Miscimarra received his JD from the University of Pennsylvania Law School and MBA from the Wharton Business School. Mr. Miscimarra will discuss these matters as well as several of the Board's more significant recent decisions.
